This year we have had the opportunity to add some significant new business delivering bulk and packed lubricants in the UK while also commencing a regular service to and from Europe.

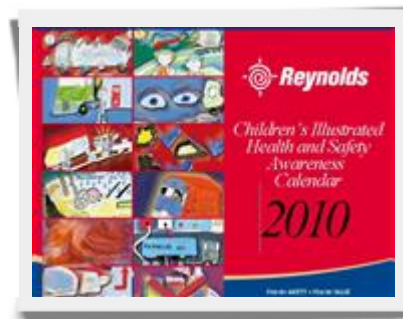
