I'm pleased to announce that as part of our ongoing commitment to safety we have decided to take a proactive step and as part of our 2010 vehicle replacement program we have specified an initial order of two vehicles to be fitted with some new technology from Mercedes Benz. The two vehicles will be fitted with Telligent stability control and Telligent Lane Assist lane recognition system.

These vehicles will be tested in a variety of locations and operating conditions, if the tests prove successful we will in future include the equipment as standard fitment on all new tractor unit purchases.

Reynolds invest in new Safety Truck



The Telligent Stability control recognises potentially dangerous situations like skidding or swerving, and acts to redress the balance by adjusting the vehicle's power supply and braking. Through systematic adjustment of the engine torque, precisely metered tractor braking and trailer braking control combine to help drivers avoid dangerous situations.

The Telligent Lane Assist lane recognition system is always on call in case the vehicle unintentionally strays too close to the edge of a lane. A small camera located behind the windscreen monitors road-markings and relays the information to an on-board computer. If the distance between the vehicle and the lane markings changes, the system alerts the driver to correct the course of the

vehicle before any problems arise.
